



Adopt a cat

You have already informed yourself in advance about the needs of cats. Now you have decided together in the family to give a cat from our shelter a home? Below you will find some information.

Requirements

Living with a cat must be well prepared. To ensure that some of the most important points are already clarified before your new family member moves in, we have put together a short overview of the conditions:

- Kittens will only be placed in free-range homes or in pairs if kept indoors or one cat must already live in the household.
- Outdoor cats are only placed in households that can guarantee that the cat can get out and in independently. We recommend a cat door (the landlord's consent is a prerequisite).
- Cats that live in flats are only placed in flats that are suitable for animals and have a secure balcony.
- Indoor cats will not be placed in single-housing unless there is a valid or medical reason.
- Free-roaming cats are not placed near busy roads

Procedure

It is very important for us if you send us the following information in advance, e.g. who you are and why one of our cats should move in with you, etc. Also a few pictures for a first impression are always welcome.

The next steps

- We will contact you by telephone or in writing to clarify further questions
- An initial appointment to visit the cat is arranged, and you will be given all the important information.
- You will then be given two to three days to think it over and will be happy to arrange a second visit to make your decision.

If this suits us both then:

- **Veterinary exit check**
All cats are tested by our vet against feline leukosis, vaccinated, dewormed twice and chipped. Cats older than 6 months are already neutered.
- **Arrangement of the collection date**

When you pick up your cat, you will sign the placement contract and pay the placement fee. You will also receive all important documents about your cat (vaccination book, aniseed registration etc.).

After your cat has moved in, we will of course be happy to answer any questions or clarifications you may have. Especially in case of medical problems within the first 14 days after taking over your cat, please contact us immediately. Our vet will be happy to advise you. In case of medical emergencies, please contact your vet immediately and inform us later.
